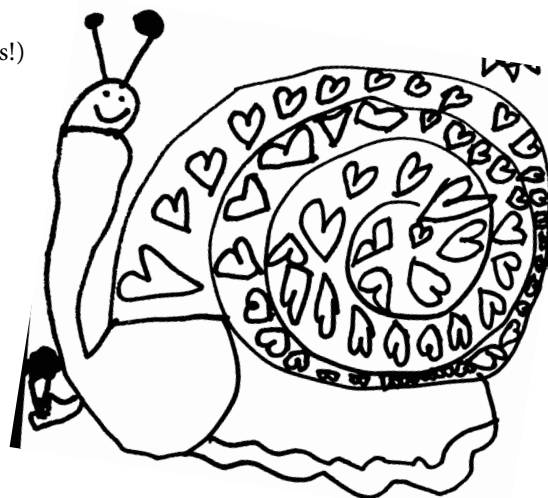

***Snow/Inclement Weather Closing Policy:** PRCP will make every effort to be open on all scheduled weekdays. However, in case of extreme inclement weather, PRCP may close or delay our opening. Closings will be recorded on our voicemail system by 7am. (at times we are also able to send an email but please do not count on it as power outages and issues with internet connection sometimes prohibit this).

Weather, driving conditions, staffing, and local district closings are all considered when deciding whether or not to close or delay school. Please call the voicemail on mornings when the weather is snowy to make sure we're open.
