Creepy Crawlies: Please dress your child for an outdoor adventure EVERY MORNING including long pants, boots, bug spray and sunscreen. We do go in the forest often and although we try to avoid ticks and poison ivy hot spots, sometimes we are exposed to them. We wash hands on return from an adventure & do a tick check but please double check daily at home.

PLEASE BRING A BACKPACK WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- filling, peanut-free, picnic lunch
- 2 portable snacks (1 for half day)
- Towel for drying off and afternoon story time
- Sunscreen & bug spray for reapplication
- 2 full extra changes of clothes (bathing suit not necessary just come in something that can get wet, muddy, or paint-y!)
- Full water bottle
- Mud boots or old sneakers for forest hikes
- Wet bag for us to send home wet clothes in

A PEEK AT OUR SUMMER DAYS...

We meet each morning in our outdoor classrooms and store our backpacks in our Outdoor Classrooms! We greet one another and spend the first part of our day exploring new sensory invitations and creating during workshop time. Each week there's a new 'make and take' invitation depending on our study; creating our very own nature kit for forest walks, walking sticks, building frog nets, exploring real tools, old school crafts, creating our own binoculars and more! . Will we go on a hike in the forest? Visit the vernal pool? Build our own mudslide? Hunt for salamanders? After workshop time we tidy up and take care of our self-care tasks, then head out on an adventure and snack picnic! We return to wash up, cool off with some lunch and social time with friends. *Our camps are staffed with our team of early education teachers and are specifically designed for early education & care.
